WHY THIS PROGRAM WORKS

The story behind seven planks, four sourcing methods, and one rustic look.



A common assumption we hear from designers: if it looks reclaimed, it's priced like reclaimed. That's true for some of our rustic plank line — and not true for most of it.

Seven products carry the rustic plank look at Stone Curators, sourced four different ways: hand-set curbstone pulled off New England roads, centuries-old granite salvaged from Asian village streets, gneiss quarried in Italy's Dolomites, and splitface granite milled as a byproduct of new curbstone production. Only two of those methods are truly reclaimed. The other two are quarried and zero-waste — priced from \$20 to \$25 a square foot.

There's a reclaimed plank look for every design and every price point — no compromising on design intent or quality.

Reclaimed stone carries decades, even centuries, of wear that can't be manufactured — which is why it costs more, and why no two lots look exactly alike. Heritage Plank Granite flips that: a genuine zero-waste product, milled from material left over from new curbstone production, with tighter color control and faster lead times than anything reclaimed. Pietra Italia Gneiss goes further still — quarried, not reclaimed, yet its natural cleft face and rust-toned patina read like a material that's already earned its age.

The result is one rustic, linear look built four different ways — so the plank changes to fit the project, not the other way around.
